



## Hockey Tournament COVID Guidelines

- **Under no circumstance** is a player, parent/guardian, coach, volunteer or spectator to come to a hockey event when they are feeling unwell, have traveled where quarantine requirements apply or where they have been told to isolate by a health professional or authority.
- Please ensure that all COVID concerns are brought to the attention of your home association and our Tournament Director.
- **Proof of second dose vaccination or exemption and a valid piece of ID is required for all eligible players, coaches, volunteers, bench staff, participants and spectators to enter any of our tournament rinks** (including those born in or before 2009), unless exempted. Arena Health Screening will also be required for all spectators upon entry (paper based or QR Code Program). Everyone entering the arena must be wearing a face mask.
- Each team must ensure that they are completing required health screening and contact tracing established by their home association prior to each tournament game. This must be up to date, accurate and available if requested. Coaches will sign their team in at the rink with Arena Staff before each game.
- Masking and Social Distancing requirements established by each Arena must be followed. Teams will be allowed to line up to begin entry to Arenas 20 minutes in advance of game time. Players are encouraged to arrive to arena dressed in order to minimize time spent in dressing rooms
- There is currently not a spectator limit for each player.
- All arena signage must be followed, this includes minimizing congestion in lobby areas and dressing rooms. Frequent hand washing or use of hand sanitizer is strongly recommended
- All coaches will be required to wear face masks when in close contact with players / coaches on the benches during game play
- At the end of games, players will put their masks on immediately and are required to change and leave dressing rooms / arenas as quickly as possible
- ***Please demonstrate kindness and respect in all arenas – we are all in this together! Inappropriate conduct will not be tolerated.***
